ORDINANCE NO. 2019-03

AN ORDINANCE OF GORDON BOROUGH, SCHUYLKILL COUNTY, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, AUTHORIZING THE PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AT THE HOBART/ROYER STREET INTERSECTION AND AT THE HOBART/OTTO STREET INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §6109(a)(1) and (6) allow boroughs to designate particular intersections as stop intersections; and

WHEREAS, Gordon Borough Council desires to so designate the intersection of Hobart and Royer Streets, and the intersection of Hobart and Otto Streets, as stop intersections, proceeding both ways; and

WHEREAS, 75 Pa.C.S.A. §6109(b) requires any such designation to be done by ordinance; and

WHEREAS, Gordon Borough has authorized and received a report of the required engineering and traffic investigation required by 75 Pa.C.S.A. §6109(e);


NOW, THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED as follows:

1. Stop signs shall be placed/erected at the intersection of Hobart Street and Royer Street, thus requiring vehicle traffic proceeding on Hobart Street through the Royer Street intersection, and vehicle traffic proceeding on Royer Street through the Hobart Street intersection, to come to a complete stop before proceeding through the intersection.
2. Stop signs shall be placed/erected at the intersections of Hobart Street and Otto Street, thus requiring vehicle traffic proceeding on Hobart Street through the Otto Street intersection, and vehicle traffic proceeding on Otto Street through the Hobart Street intersection, to come to a complete stop before proceeding through the intersection.
3. Borough officials are authorized to draw clearly marked stop lines at the intersections of Hobart and Royer Streets, and Hobart and Otto Streets, to designate the location at which vehicle traffic is to come to a complete stop at said intersections.
4. Whether or not clearly marked stop lines are drawn as authorized by Paragraph 3 of this Ordinance, enforcement of this Ordinance shall be through 75 Pa.C.S.A. §3323.
5. If any part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the rest and the remainder of this Ordinance is affirmed and shall remain in full force and effect.
6. If any prior ordinances of Gordon Borough are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, the inconsistent portions of such prior ordinances are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give effect to the provisions of this Ordinance.
7. This Ordinance shall be effective immediately upon enactment or on the first day authorized by law thereafter.
